

Appendix 1: TJ Fellowship Person Specification

Eligibility

Essential Criteria:

- TJ Fellowships are available for medically qualified candidates
- Applicants should be near to gaining their Certificate of Completion of Training in medical oncology, clinical oncology, neurology, radiology or pathology

Desirable Criteria:

- Evidence of commitment to neuro-oncology within own speciality
 - Intercalated honours degree and/or additional qualifications e.g. MSc/PhD etc.
